1. Unless otherwise stated, the rules of the Badminton Association of Hong Kong, China (HKBA) shall be applied.
2. For other rules and regulations, please refer to the Secondary Schools General Information Booklet issued by Hong Kong Island & Kowloon Regional Committee (English P.29, Chinese P.23) and New Territories Regional Committee (Chinese P.19).
3. System of Play:
  - 3.1 The tournament is run on a knock-out basis.
  - 3.2 Based on the Badminton World Federation, the 21 points/game system is adopted for all games including singles and doubles. The winner of the match shall be the team that wins 3 games first.
  - 3.3 The order of play shall be as follows:

2	First Doubles	First Doubles
3	Second Singles	Second Singles
4	Second Doubles	Second Doubles
5	Third Singles	Third Singles
  - 3.4 Each team shall be arranged in such a way as to provide 3 singles and 2 doubles. Players can play in one single and one doubles pairing only, and two singles cannot play together in a doubles game. Doubles players cannot play in two doubles.
  - 3.5 The Tournament is an open grade competition and run on a school basis. Participating schools may send any of their registered students to take part regardless of the grades in which their students are registered.
  - 3.6 A team for each match shall consist of 5 to 7 players. There must be at least 5 players present before the start of any match.
  - 3.7 Teams should report to roll-call area 20 minutes before the scheduled time of the match and

must fill in the team list. If any team is not ready to start the match on time, shall lead to declare a walk-over.

3.8 No alteration thereof shall be made after submission of respective team list. Any discrepancy will lead to the forfeiture of the game(s) in question.

3.9 **Players must present their valid HKSSF Student Registration Card 2023-2024 (either Physical or Electronic) before the match starts, otherwise, he/she will not be allowed to compete.**

4. Uniform:

4.1 In general, please refer to General Rules of Sports Competition item 7

4.2 Players must wear appropriate sportswear when participating in the competition and it is not necessary for all team players to dress in identical uniform with same colour and same style.

4.3 Players will be ruled as walk-over if any of the mentioned rules are breached.

5. RSL Tourney#1 (Speed 50) will be used as the official shuttlecock.

6. Prizes:

6.1 The top 4 winning teams in Boys and Girls Team will be awarded.

6.2 Awarding schools will receive 1 Trophy, 9 medals and 9 certificates.

7. Others:

7.1 Only during the specific time out interval, two coaches or team manager from the designated coaching area may coach the players. No interference or distraction by the coach or team manager is allowed during the game. If the referee finds the behaviour or actions of any coach is unfair or causes disturbance to competition, he/she may request the coach/team manager to leave the field of play.

7.2 Participating teams must be accompanied by one Team Manager who is a full time staff member or an authorized member (non-staff member) appointed and registered with HKSSF, otherwise teams will not be allowed to participate in the Tournament. The Team Manager shall be responsible for the conduct of the athletes, students and supporters both on and off the field.

Registration: Application of non-staff member must be submitted online at least four working days prior to the Team Manager's assumption of duty. (<https://star.hkssf.org.hk/login>)

7.3 Official referees shall be appointed by the Hong Kong Badminton Association for all matches. For all technical problems, the referee's decision is final.

7.4 In the event of bad weather, team manager, referee and player should refer to the HK Observatory weather report as indication; 6:30am for competition before 1:00pm and 11:00am for competition on or after 1:00pm. All competitions will be cancelled automatically whenever air pollution index reaches 10+, typhoon signal No. 3, red rainstorm warning, or other higher warning signal is hoisted. However, if matches have been started, the duty officer and the referee will decide whether or not the matches will continue. Please refer to the Secondary Schools General Information Booklet 2023-2024 for further details.

7.5 The Organizer has the right to make necessary changes and its decision will be final in all cases.
